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# the DIQ play date



### GAME 1

#### **Jumping Beans**

The aim of the game is to see who can jump the furthest! This game is great fun indoors or out!



- 1. Make sure you have lots of space so that everyone has lots of room to jump about.
- 2. Put on some music, your children's favourite songs is a good place to start or make a playlist of some upbeat popular tunes.
- 3. Ask everyone to stand on a starting line.
- 4. Count down 3, 2, 1 to a long jump!

#### GAME 2

#### **Hide and Seek**

An old family favourite!

- 1. Choose someone to be the seeker and they must close their eyes and count to 10 while everybody else hides... no peeking!
- 2. When they have finished counting they have to shout 'coming... ready or not'.
- 3. The seeker needs to find where everyone else has hidden.
- 4. The last person to be found is the seeker next time!
- 5. Add a twist by getting those found to hold hands and join the search for the others - so you end up with a chain of seekers!

### GAME 3



**Happy Families** It's no secret that we love roleplay games and little ones just love to play happy families.

- 1. Each child takes a different role in the family.
- 2. They act that role and undertake daily chores mimicking what they see their mummies, daddies, aunites, uncles and grandparents do.
- 3. Make it fun by asking them to make you a cup of tea, make you a sandwich or send them to the supermarket.
- 4. It's an opportunity to get creative with their Little Tikes toys. Encourage them to play with their Cozy Coupes, play houses or kitchens. They'll love it!

### **GAME 4**

#### What's the Time Mr Wolf?

It's a favourite that we all loved to play! It's great for teaching little ones how to count.

- 1. Choose someone to be Mr Wolf and get them to stand up against a wall, facing away from the rest of the children.
- 2. Get the other children to line up a few metres way.
- 3. Ask everyone to shout 'What's the time Mr Wolf?'
- 4. Mr Wolf will then tell them the time (1 o'clock, 2 o'clock, 3 o'clock etc.) and the children will need to move that many steps forward.
- 5. Repeat until Mr Wolf decides it's 'dinner time' and he will chase the other children who have to reach their starting point to be safe.
- 6 Whoever is caught first is the next Mr Wolf!

### **GAME 5**

#### **Treasure Hunt**

It might be some chocolate coins or another prize at the end of the trail, like a day out!

- 1. Pick your treasure and decide where you want to hide it.
- 2. Set a series of simple clues to lead your team to the treasure.
- 3. Get the kids to work as a team to find each clue to the prize!
- 4. It's hours of fun for everyone in your household!


#### **Outdoor - On Your Marks**


- 1. Set-up a little Cozy Coupe race track for your little ones.

- 7. You can also create a 'Single Player' version, by setting up a mini race track for them to drive through.




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
