



The batteries included in the engine are for in-store demonstration. Before playing, an adult must install fresh alkaline batteries (not included) in the unit. Here's how:


- Using a Phillips screwdriver (not included) remove the screw and battery compartment cover from the under the engine.

- 3. Replace the compartment cover and tighten the screw.






Please follow instructions carefully.

Set railroad parts close together or far apart to test your slammin' skills!



Turn the engine ON (I). It will make engine sound effects.




Slam the button on the engine to watch it go and hear driving sounds! Slam the button while the engine is driving to for special boost sound effects and extra distance!




Open the cover on the water tower to release the balls onto the engine as it passes by.
