- 4. Remove the tab from under your Tobi™ Friend and discard. (Fig. 3)








INTERACT WITH OTHER TOBI™ FRIENDS




REPLACING THE BATTERIES

- 2. Using a Phillips screwdriver (not included) remove the screw and battery compartment cover from under the unit.

3. Install six (6) 1.5V AG13 (LR44) alkaline batteries (not included) making sure the (+) and (-) ends face the proper direction as indicated inside the battery compartment.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Temporary battery box is not a toy.
- Play is limited in TRY ME mode (temporary battery box still connected). Remove the temporary battery box before playing, and remove the pull tab from the battery compartment under your Tobi™ Friend.
- After approximately two minutes of inactivity, your Tobi™ Friend will enter sleep mode. Wake it up by pressing the button on its head.
- Ensure the switch under your Tobi™ Friend is moved to the OFF (O) position after use to conserve battery power.
