#### **BATTERY REPLACEMENT**

The batteries included in the units are for in-store demonstration. Before playing, an adult must install fresh alkaline batteries (not included) in the units. Here's how:

- 1. Using a Phillips screwdriver (not included), remove the screw and battery compartment covers located on the back of the guitar, under the keyboard and drum set.
- 2. Install three (3) fresh 1.5V AA (LR6) alkaline batteries (not included) in each unit, making sure the (+) and (-) ends face the proper direction as indicated inside the battery compartment.
- 3. Replace the compartment covers and tighten the screws.



# **Bluetooth**

Jam out to your favorite song by connecting the guitar to your device. Here's how:

- 1. Move the switch or dial to the Bluetooth® icon on your unit. It will continuously play music while it is searching for your device.
- 2. Open the settings menu on your device.
- 3. Select Bluetooth® on your device and make sure it is on.
- 4. Your device will search for the guitar, drums or keyboard.
- 5. Select the name "MGA Electric Guitar," "MGA Electric Drums," or "MGA Electric Keyboard," to connect your device.

NOTES: • You can only connect one instrument at a time to your device.

 Each instrument can only connect to one smart device at a time. You will not be able to connect two devices to the same instrument.

Keyboard: Continuously play the keys to start the song. If you stop playing the keyboard, the song will continue for a few seconds and then pause. Play the keyboard again to continue the song.

For the best experience, choose a song that fits the instrument's genre.
