


## Adjusting the Seat

### Let's be careful!

#### **WARNING!** • ADULT ASSEMBLY REQUIRED.

- · Adult supervision required. Do not leave children unattended. Please keep this manual as it contains important information.
- Ride-on toys should not be used near swimming pools, on or near steps, hills, roadways, or inclines.
- Shoes must be worn at all times.
- Only one rider at a time.
- Maximum weight limit: 50 lbs. (23 Kg)
- This product is intended for use by children ages 3 to 5 years.
- Not to be used by children over 5 years due to size limitations.
  This product is intended for indoor and outdoor family use only.
- Ride-on toys should be used with caution since skill is required to avoid falls or collisions which may cause injury to the user or third parties.
- Keep long hair and loose apparel away from the moving wheels.
- Any contact with moisture or liquid may damage the electronics. To prolong the life and operation of the sound module, bring product indoors during inclement weather and conditions.

### **Battery Safety Information.** This is serious!

#### FCC COMPLIANCE

• Keep these instructions for future reference. • Requires 3 "AAA" (LR03) alkaline batteries (not included).

- (Rechargeable batteries may be substituted.) • The voltage of a fully-charged, rechargeable battery is often lower than that of a fresh alkaline battery. Therefore, it is recommended that alkaline batteries be used instead of rechargeable batteries for best performance and longer play time.
- Install batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- To avoid battery leakage:
- 1. Follow the toy and battery manufacturer's installation
- instructions. 2. Do not mix old and new batteries.
- 3. Do not mix standard (carbon-zinc), alkaline or rechargeable batteries. Do not mix different brands of batteries. Only batteries
- of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used. 4. When toy is not used for an extended period of time, remove
- batteries to prevent possible leakage and damage to the unit. 5. Remove dead or exhausted batteries from product.
- 6. Dispose of dead batteries properly; do not bury. Do not dispose of batteries in fire as they may leak or explode.
- Make sure cover is properly installed on unit at all times.
- Do not attempt to recharge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before recharging.
- Charging of rechargeable batteries should be done by an adult. • The supply terminals are not to be short circuited.
- NOTE: If the unit stops working or doesn't work as it should,
- remove the batteries for a few minutes and then re-insert them. If there is still a problem, install new batteries

#### LIMITED WARRANTY





## **Finish with the Arms** Snap on the Arms (G) to each side of the front of the Base (C).









## **Attach the Bottom Plate**

Attach the Bottom Plate (E) to the bottom of the Base (C) using six screws (J). ASSEMBLY TIP: Turn the dino upside down to attach the plate.



## Add the Seat

Snap the Seat (F) to the back of the Base (C) by inserting the tabs under the Seat into the tracks and slot of the Base.



## **Before you begin, install the batteries!**

### **Before beginning, an adult must install fresh alkaline batteries. Here's how:** 1. Using a Phillips screwdriver (not included), remove the screws and battery compartment cover


- Using a Phillips screwdriver (not included), remove the screws and battery compartment cover located on top of the dino's head.
- 2. Install three (3) fresh 1.5V AAA (LR03) alkaline batteries (not included) making sure the (+) and (-) ends face the proper direction as indicated inside the battery compartment.
- 3. Replace the compartment cover and tighten the screws.






### Start Building

Slide the Base (C) over the post on the Front Wheel (B).






Attach the Handle (A) to the Base (C) by sliding it over the post of the Front Wheel (B). Secure the Handle to the Base using one Screw (I).
