


Start the Foam Party

Plug the blower and turn it on by moving the switch on the side of the blower from the OFF position to the ON. Then, plug in the pump.



Foam Party Tricks

- Before playing, make sure the electrical plugs are a safe distance away from the water and foam.
- The foam machine can be placed on grass or concrete surfaces, but it is recommended to use on grass.
- This product is soapy and can cause certain surfaces to become slippery. Always use caution when walking on slippery surfaces.
- For more voluminous foam, it is recommended to use the foam machine in a smaller contained area.
- To evenly spread the foam in larger areas, an adult should remove the blower from the stand and move it around the play area.
- An adult must always supervise while the machine is running to avoid the foam bubbles getting sucked into the machine.
- Keep the machine away from the foam at all times and do not allow the foam to rise above the stand.
- Do not set up machine during windy or rainy weather.

Store until your next party!

Before storing, it is important to drain any remaining foam from the pump. Fill the bin one quarter of the way with water and then allow the machine to run to clear out any soapy foam from the pump. Once the machine has filtered through the water begin disassembling the foam machine as described below.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Allow the contents to air dry thoroughly before storing in the bin.

1. Turn off the blower. Then, unplug the blower and pump.

- 2. Disconnect the hose from both the blower and pump. Then, remove the blower from the stand.
- 3. Remove the mesh sock and allow it to air dry.
- 4. Twist off and remove the adapter.
- 5. Disassemble the stand.
- 6. Store the contents in the bin.

Time to tidy up!

• Once the foam has dried out, hose down the area with water. Repeat a couple of times until the surface is no longer slippery. • Wash off any remaining residue on your body with mild soap and water.

Having problems?

PROBLEM	SOLUTION
Foam got into the blower.	Turn the blower off and allow it to dry out before using again.
Foam isn't growing.	 Check that the solution is 5:1. It should be five parts of water to one part of foam solution. Use in a smaller contained area.
Foam is too wet.	Check that the solution is 5:1. It should be five parts of water to one part of foam solution.
Pump does not draw water or the flow is slow.	Make sure it is plugged in and the power supply is compatible.
Pump is making noises.	The water level is lower than the water intake.
Pump is not working.	There might be an internal issue. Contact Consumer Service at 1-800-321-0183.
Ran out of solution.	FOAMO refills are available in select retailers. Visit www.getfoamo.com for more information.









Add Water and Foam Solution


Fill the bin with water up the fill line located inside on the shorter side of the bin. Then, add the whole bottle of foam solution. Mix the solution and slightly close the lid. Do not tightly close the lid to avoid damaging the hose and pump's wire. Always wash your hands after contact with the solution.



Slide the other end of the hose (E) through the handle on the blower and over the









Secure the Foam Machine the Stand

Lift up and slide out the locks on the stand. Then, slide the foam machine's legs into slots on the stand. Secure it in place by lifting and sliding the locks over the openings on the back of the foam machine.



Prepare the Pump

Place the pump (D) into the bin and attach the suction cups under the pump to the bottom floor of the bin. Then, insert one side of the hose (E) into the tube of the pump.

NOTE: Set up as close to power source as possible. The product should be periodically examined for potentially unsafe conditions such as: damaged cord, plug, housing or parts, and that in the event such damage is found, the product should not be used until properly repaired. Never leave the blower outside in the rain or exposed to the elements when not in use. When in use, do not place the cord across traffic areas, water or damp areas. The blower should be placed on a stable surface and anchored per product instructions. The power cord of the blower is equipped with a Ground Fault Circuit Interrupter (GFCI) plug.

1) Make sure that the blower switch is in the "OFF" position. Plug the blower into a properly grounded 110-120V GFCI outlet.

- 2) If the GFCI has been tripped, press the "RESET" button to restore power to the blower.
- 3) Set the power switch of the blower to "ON." After use, turn the power to "OFF."
- 4) To disconnect, have an adult grip it tightly and pull the plug from wall outlet.

- WARNING: Failure to follow these instructions could result in serious injury or death.



This product should be grounded. In the event of an electrical short circuit, grounding reduces the risk of electric shock by providing an escape wire for the electrical circuit. 
Assemble the Foam Machine


Attach the adapter (B) to the blower (A). Twist to lock in place, making sure that the foam apparatus is seated on the top of the adapter.



Time to Add the Mesh Sock Wrap the mesh sock (C) around the adapter (B). Secure it by closing the hook

and loop fastener on the mesh sock.









Finish the Legs

Insert the last four legs (F) into the connectors (H).



Top it Off

Attach the legs to the bottom of the table (I).

Do not place the blower in an area where it can draw up dirt, leaves and other debris. Make sure that the blower is at least 6.6 ft. (2m) away from any structure or obstacle such as a fence, garage, overhanging branches or electrical wires.

▲ Safety Warnings: ELECTRICAL PUMP

- Before using, make sure the power supply is compatible with the pump. This pump is operated by 120V AC, 60Hz, 23W power supply
- Pump should be periodically examined for potentially unsafe conditions such as damaged cord, plug, housing, or parts, and that in the event such damage is found, the product should not be used until properly repaired. If the plug on the power cable is damaged or cracked, discontinue use immediately.
- If pump is making abnormal noises or has an odor, unplug it from the power supply and do not use until it is properly repaired.
- Only use in water with temperature of 32° F (0° C) to 95° F (35° C), as temperature below or above this range will damage the pump.
- Pump should only be operated in depths of 3.2 ft. (1 m).
- Always handle the product with care. In case of a serious impact, inspect the product and discontinue use if there are signs of damage.
- Disconnect from the power supply when cleaning or installing the pump to prevent electric shock.


